Maximum weekly benefit	\$286.07

Benefits for totally incapacity for work

First 45 weeks after discharge	100% of normal earnings
Subsequently	75% of normal earnings
Minimum	Federal Minimum Wage
Lump sum redemption level	\$184.11
Remuneration loading for discharged members	\$130.88

Up to \$1,472.90
